

HIGHER EDUCATION: METHODS OF CONSUMPTION

In the days of rotary phones and roll-down car windows, cannabis consumption methods were pretty limited. Back then, smoking a joint, taking a bong rip, or eating a questionably dosed brownie were the most common ways to consume cannabis. Nowadays, since plant medicine can be consumed in many different ways, people who are uncomfortable with traditional smoking can still experience the benefits of cannabis. Whether you're an experienced cannabis enthusiast, looking to return to consumption after a hiatus, or are a canna-curious newbie, there's a method to match your personal preferences.

Inhalation through smoking or vaping is the most commonly used method to consume cannabis. When THC is delivered directly to the lungs, the effects can be felt quickly.

Some people prefer to **smoke their dried flower** in joints, bowls, or water pipes. These days, pre-rolls are a great option for people who are new to cannabis or aren't comfortable rolling their own. However, others who may be sensitive to traditional smoking may opt for vaping instead. Inhaling vaporized cannabis with a vape pen, a dried flower device, or a dab rig can provide a smoother hit and a more discreet experience than other smoking methods.

Edibles and Oral Options allow consumers to ingest cannabis and experience the benefits of plant medicine without smoking or vaping.

Gummies and tablets are some of the most popular ways to consume cannabis orally. They come in a wide variety of flavors and can be used discreetly. Also, since these edibles are pre-dosed and labeled in licensed dispensaries, controlling the experience is fairly foolproof. However, starting slow with a low-dose edible is recommended for anyone new to cannabis to avoid an unpleasant or overwhelming experience.

Tinctures are liquids that are placed sublingually, or under the tongue, where the active ingredients are absorbed quickly and the effects can be felt in minutes. Swallowing a tincture will cause it to be processed through digestion, just like a gummy, so the onset of effects will take longer to be felt.

Cannabis infused beverages are relatively new and gaining in popularity. These drinks can be purchased in stores and online, making them a convenient alternative to traditional alcoholic beverages in social settings.

Although topicals are not technically consumed, they are a safe and user-friendly way for people to try plant medicine. With topicals such as lotions or skin care creams, consumers can reap targeted, pain-relieving benefits of cannabis without any unwanted psychoactive effects.
